Dear Parent/Caregiver

This letter is to inform you of the Student Resource Scheme (SRS) for 2018. Total for 2018 will be \$50 Prep – Year 6.

## **Goods and services provided but not limited to are:**

- Class curriculum, consisting of reproduced class workbooks and worksheets and teacher-prepared material which substitute for textbooks
- Course consumables purchased through the school such as art material, science equipment, maths equipment etc
- Consumables purchased for use with the Visual Arts Program, Under 8s Day Celebrations, Mini Minds Alive Program
- Online subscriptions. We currently offer Sunshine On-Line Subscription to Junior Students for use at school and home (\$99/student/year for parent to purchase) and IXL Maths for the Senior Students (\$99/student/year for parent to purchase)..
- Words their Way textbooks - \$49.95 each should a member of public wish to purchase privately. 6 books in total.
- Apps purchased for student's use on class iPads, XO's
- Printing of assignment materials for students (\$5 for year – extra if your child uses all allocated)
- RIBBiT Rewards Day activities
- Bus subsidies for various Curriculum related excursions
- School subsidised Maths/Author visits

Other charges that may relate to your child/ren include the Music Levy for students who participate in the Instrumental Music Program which is \$20 for the year. If your child uses a school instrument you will be required to pay a \$60 hire charge for the year. There will also be a fee for Religious Instruction books for \$6 for students who participate in the RI program.

Payment is required by **29<sup>th</sup> March 2018** to participate in this scheme. Payment can be made either by cash, EFTPOS, Credit Card, BPoint or Centrepay. **If you wish to pay via Centrepay please see our Business Services Manager to set this payment option up.**

If you do not elect to join the scheme you are required to return the Participation Agreement Form, **clearly** indicating your intentions not to participate and you understand that you will be required to supply the necessary items required for your student to engage with the curriculum (as outlined in paragraph 12), to the school office by **29<sup>th</sup> March 2018**. Once this form is submitted you will then be issued with a list of items you **must** supply that form part of the Student Resource Scheme levy for your child's educational needs.

As the scheme operates for the benefit of participating parents and is funded solely from participation fees, resources provided by the scheme will not be issued to students whose parents choose not to participate.
